*****BOIL ORDER LIFTED*****

The Genesee County Drain Commissioner's Office announces, as of 2:00 p.m. today, October 20, 2021, the precautionary Boil Order for Clayton Township and Gaines Township has been lifted.

The City of Swartz Creek, who maintains their own DPW, has also lifted the Boil Order for their municipality.

The advisory was issued Monday, out of an abundance of caution due to a loss pressure in Swartz Creek's water distribution system caused by a water main break.

This afternoon our office received results from the second of two consecutive rounds of 24-hour testing. The samples were collected from the affected areas, and both rounds of sampling showed results within normal established parameters for safe drinking water.

The patience and understanding exhibited by the residents of these communities throughout the past two days has been greatly appreciated.
