- A. All trucked or hauled wastes to be discharged to the POTW must be accompanied by a completed waste manifest form signed by the permittee.
- B. The manifest must be reviewed by the POTW Manager prior to commencing discharge of the load.
- C. Trucked or hauled pollutants will be accepted only if transported to the POTW in compliance with state and federal hazardous waste and liquid industrial waste laws.

## GLOSSARY

**STANDARD INDUSTRIAL CODE (SIC):** This is a way of identifying industrial types with a four-digit code. A manual with the codes is entitled *The Standard Industrial Classification Manual*, and is available in the reference section of most libraries.

**“Domestic Septage”** means liquid or solid material removed from a septic tank, cesspool, portable toilet, type III marine sanitation device, or similar storage or treatment works that receives only domestic waste. Domestic septage does not include liquid or solid material removed from a septic tank, cesspool, or similar facility that receives either commercial wastewater or industrial wastewater and does not include grease removed from a grease interceptor, grease trap, or other appurtenance used to retain grease or other fatty substances contained in restaurant waste.
